- The other players take turn asking yes-or-no questions. They cannot ask if a certain number is the secret one, but they can ask questions such as:



- Players cross out the numbers they eliminate.
- The player who finds the secret number wins.

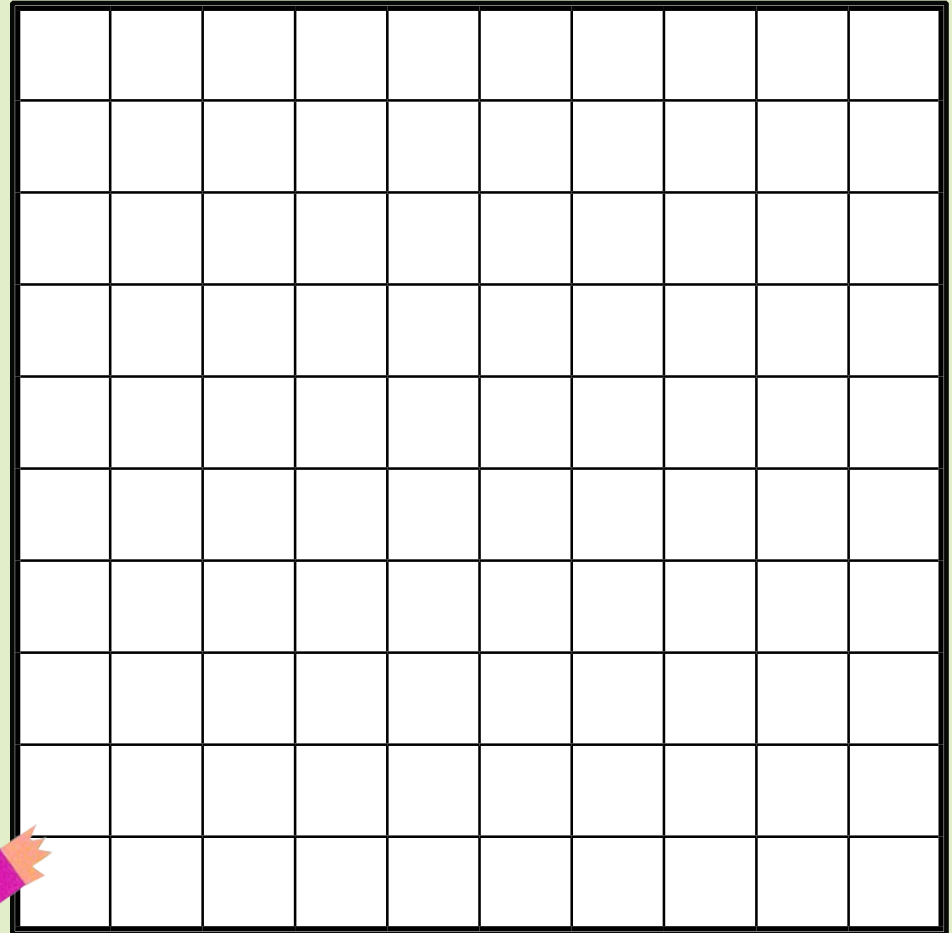
Number of players: 2 to 6
